After falling behind by double digits in the first quarter, the Shock slowly clawed their way back the rest of the game but fell just short, falling to the Sparks 92-87 at home. The Shock outscored the Sparks by 10 (48-38) in the second half but also missed nine free throws (six of them in the second half) which ultimately cost them the game. Tina Thompson led the Sparks with 24 points, 11 rebounds and five assists while Penicheiro added nine assists of her own. The Shock were led in scoring by Ivory Latta who had a single-game season high 26 points for the Shock. Tiffany Jackson recorded the first double-double of her career with 11 points and 13 rebounds (seven of them offensive) and three steals. Marion Jones started and played the entire third quarter with the Shock, recording five points, two rebounds and providing a much needed spark that cut Los Angeles' lead to just three with less than two minutes left in the game. The loss was the Shock's fourth in a row.

Third quarter struggles continued for Tulsa Friday night at San Antonio's AT&T Center as they were defeated by the Silver Stars 94-74. The Shock were outscored by 10 points in that quarter and were never able to chip away at San Antonio's lead after that. The game started out promising for Tulsa, with the team sinking its first five field goals before a miss by Nicole Ohlde at the 4:44 mark. Later the Shock went on a 7-0 run at the end of the second quarter, closing the half with a 22-foot three pointer by Amber Holt cutting the San Antonio lead to 47-46 after two quarters. Four Tulsa players scored in double-digits: Ohlde (10), Robinson (14), Latta (13), and Crossley (11). Tulsa also outperformed the Silver Stars at the free-throw line, making 77 percent (10-13) of its shots from there compared to San Antonio's 60 percent (12-20). However, San Antonio posted better percentages in both field goals (52-49 percent) as well as three-pointers (38-29 percent). The crowd of 10,244 watching the match was a record for San Antonio this season. The loss was the Shocks' third in a row.

The Tulsa Shock scored a mere nine points in the first quarter of Saturday's game that would result in a league record-setting margin of victory for the Seattle Storm at Seattle's Key Arena, ending up with a 65-111 final score. The matchup came less than a week after Tulsa broke a long home losing streak by beating the Storm at the BOK Center, 84-75. Two Shock players, Ivory Latta (14) and Shanna Crossley (12), scored double digits in points. Seattle scored more than twice as many points as the Shock in the first half, entering halftime with 60 points to Tulsa's 27.

The Storm had a total of seven players score double-digits in points, including Lauren Jackson accomplishing her eighth double-double of the season with 12 points and 10 rebounds. The Shock was not able to gain the lead once throughout the entire game, and Seattle remains undefeated at home for the season.

- At 34-years-old, Marion Jones is the oldest rookie to play in the WNBA this season

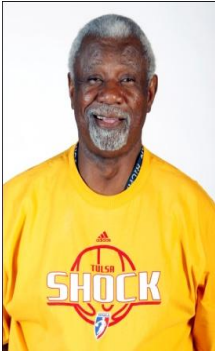

WNBA CAREER TRENDS AND NOTES

- Hired as the General Manager and Head Coach by the Tulsa Shock on October 20, 2009.

GENERAL CAREER NOTES

- Won a National Junior College championship in 1980 at Western Texas College
- Head coach at the University of Tulsa from 1981 to 1985, leading Tulsa to the NIT championship in 1981 and compiling a 119-37 record over five seasons.
- Became the head coach of the University of Arkansas in 1985.
- Took the University of Arkansas to the Final Four three times, losing to Duke in the semifinals in 1990, winning the National Championship in 1994 against Duke, and losing in the Championship game to UCLA in 1995.
- Named National Coach of the Year in 1994.
- His teams typically played an up tempo game with intense pressure defense – a style that was known as “40 Minutes of Hell.”
- Winningest coach in Arkansas history, compiling a 389-169
- From 2005 to 2007, Richardson served as the head coach of the Panamanian National team
- In March 2007, Richardson was named the head coach of the Mexican National Team.
